


**The New Boy** 


The new boy has a disability. Some children laugh. Manu cannot kick a ball but there is something he can do. What makes the children shout and cheer?

Manu looked different. Some children giggled. As he walked to his seat, they saw that he was disabled. He sat next to Peter.




At lunchtime Manu sat down under a tree. Some children looked at him. They laughed and giggled. Peter saw the new boy. He went over to him.

Joe came over to Maria and her friends. "Don't be unkind," he said. "Manu is just like us."




