

Tin Trong, the Little Bus







One day, Tin Trong is exhausted. He reaches his parking space late.




Tin Trong coughs.

Khoo, Khoo, Khong, Khong!


He is too sick to drive tomorrow.






Ngeet Ngeet! Cheet, Cheet! Bang Bang! Bang Bang! Now, Tin Trong feels better. Actually, he feels great!
