

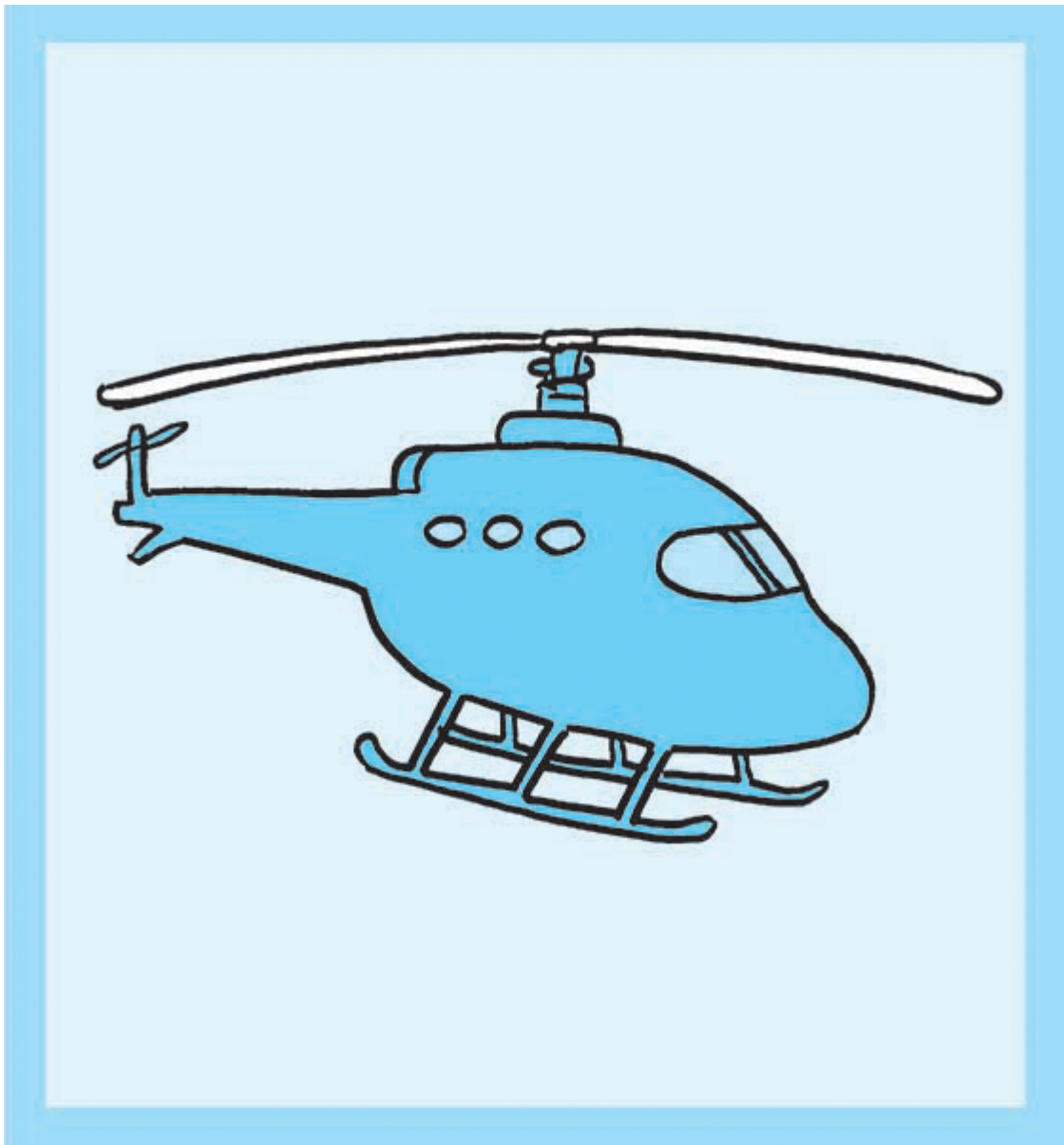

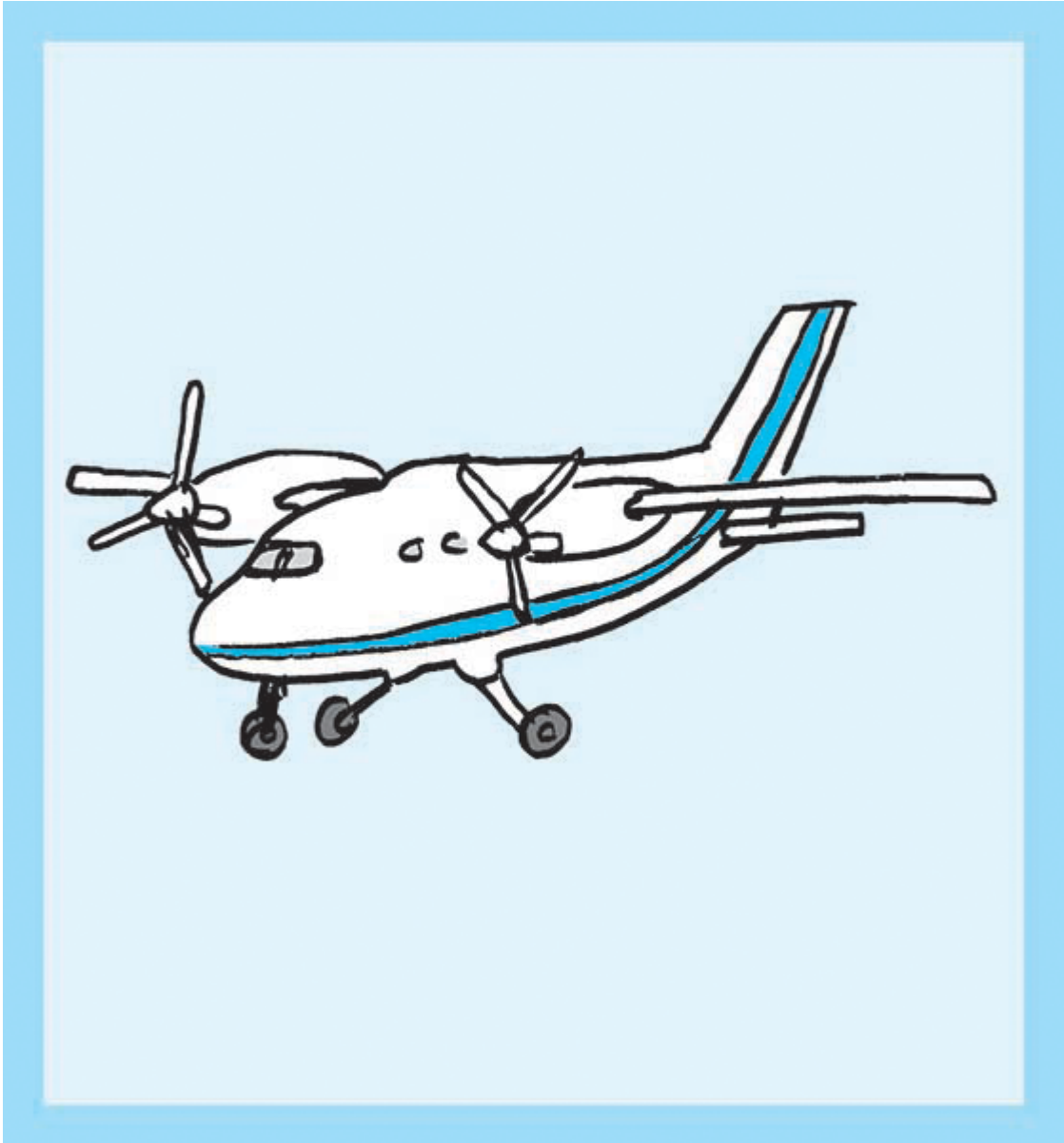
Read about different types of transport. A family travel by boat, plane and bus. Where do you think they are going?



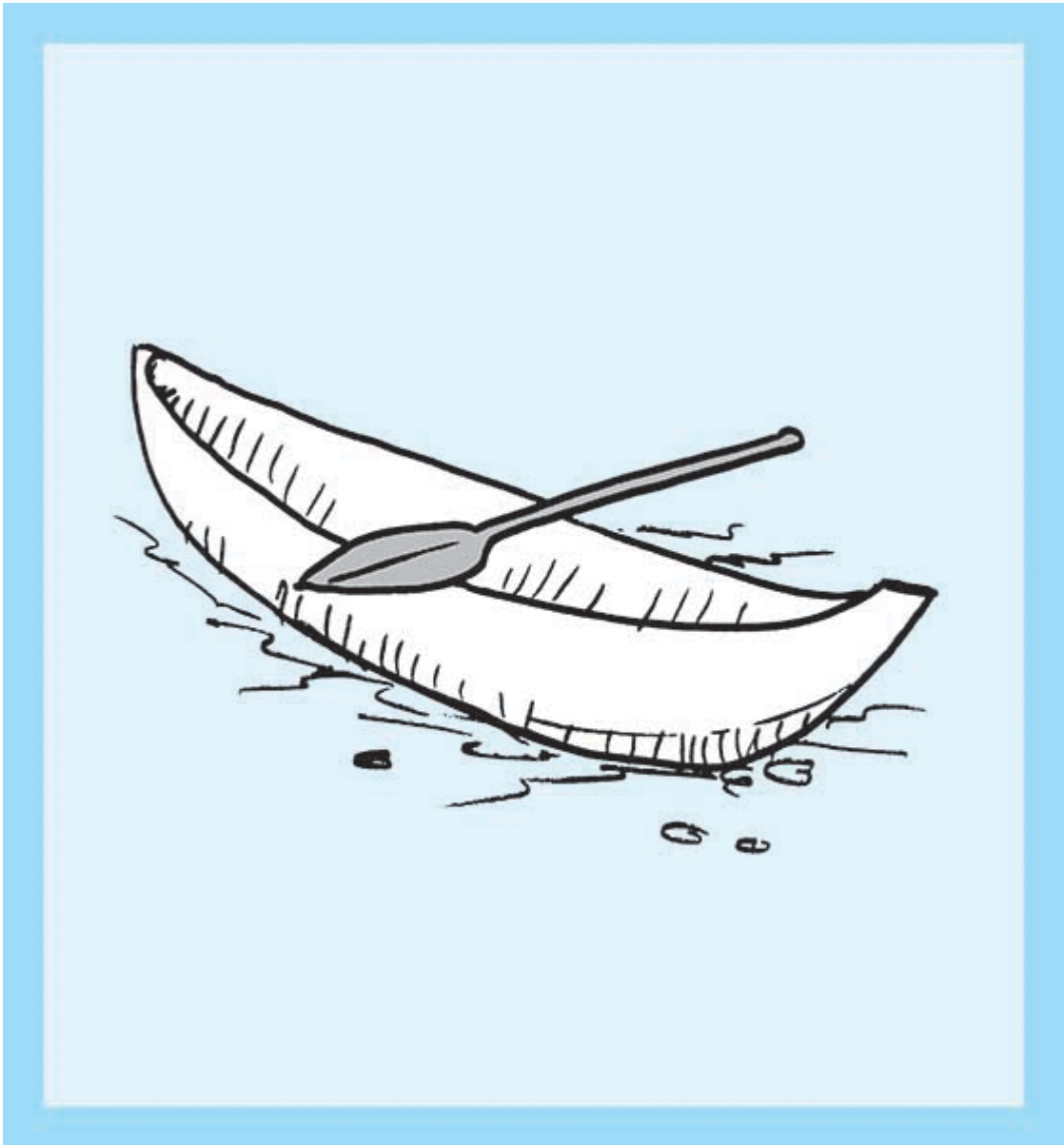

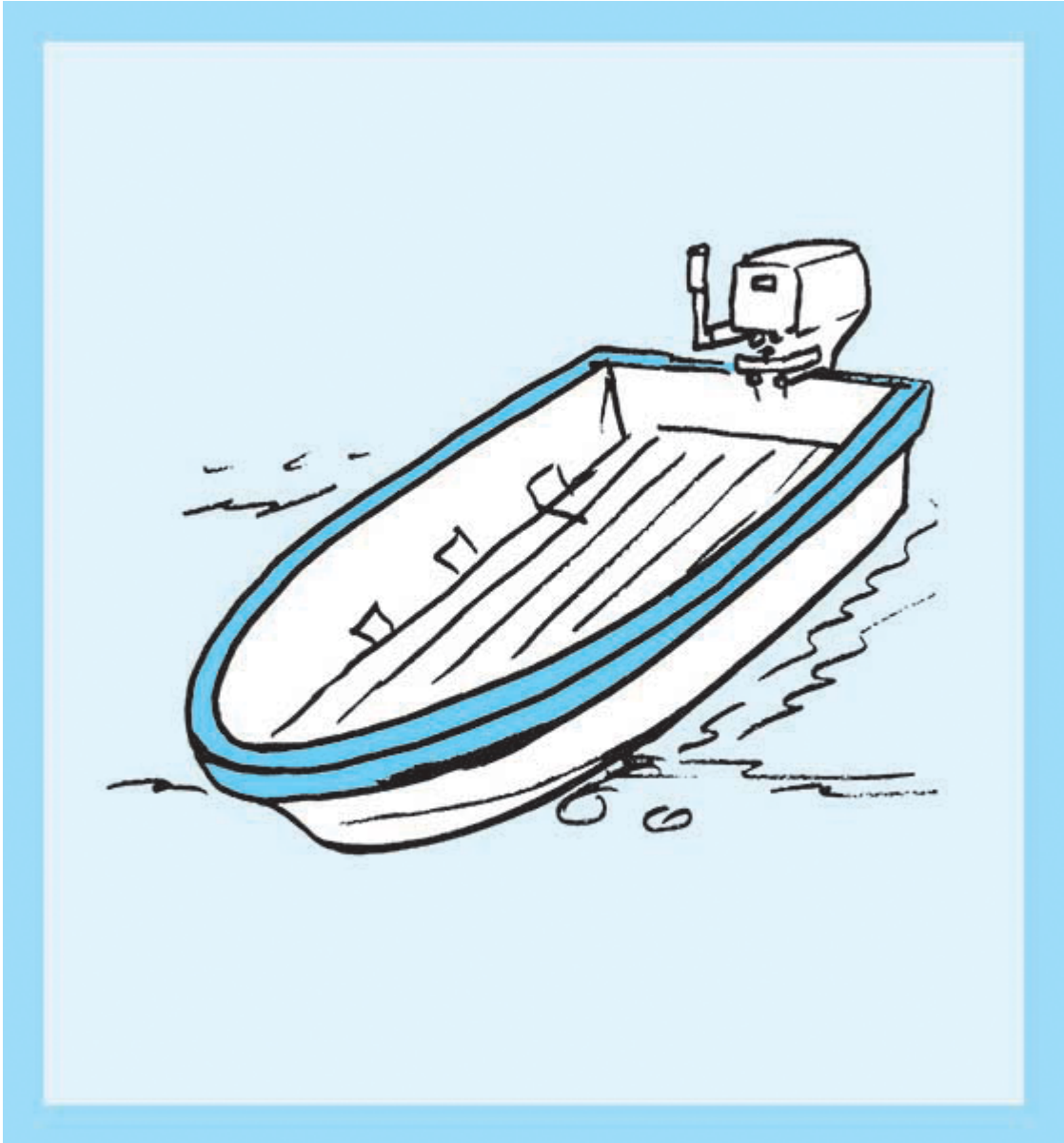
Transport This is a helicopter.



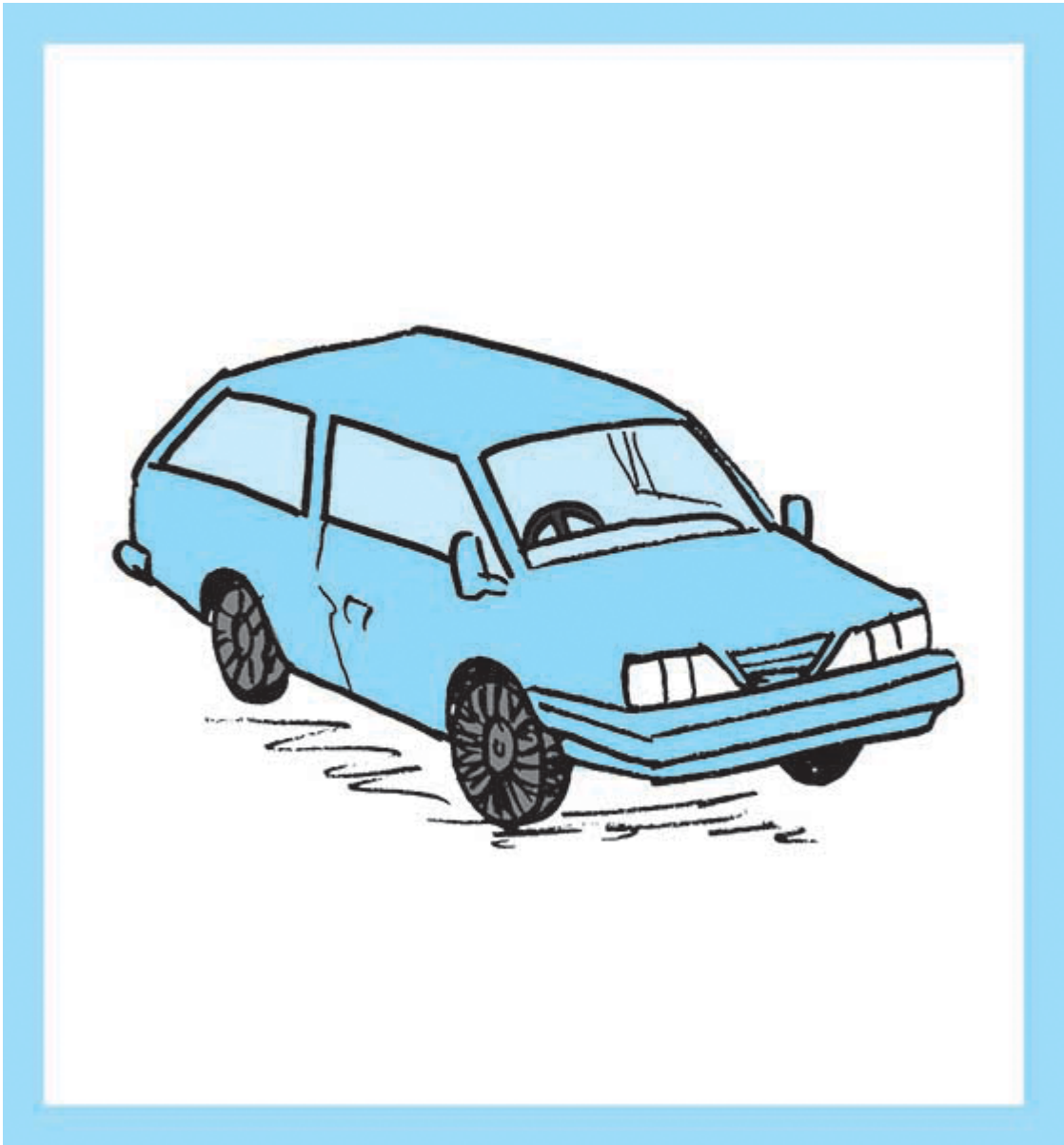
This is a plane.



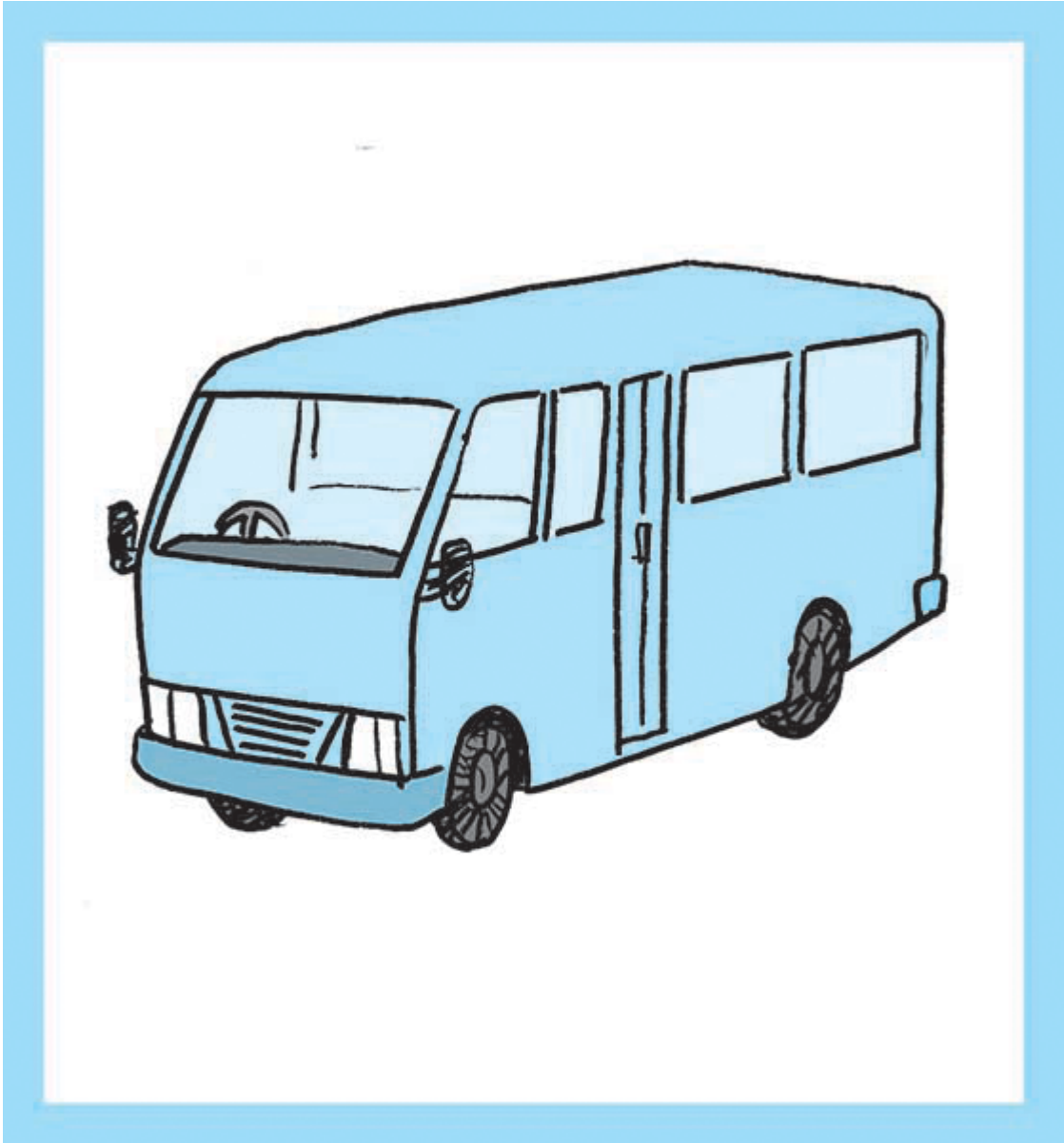
This is a canoe.



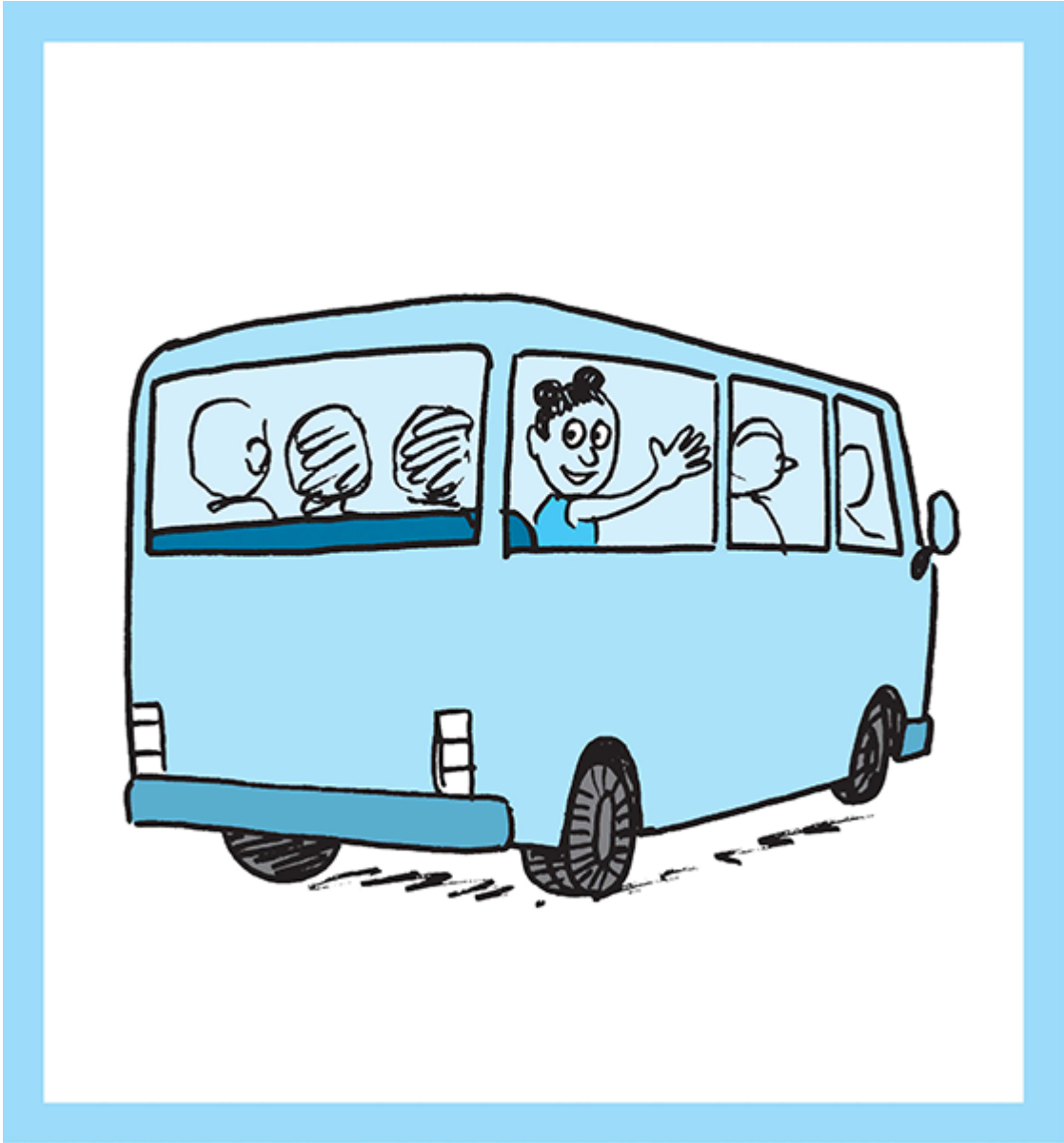
This is a boat.



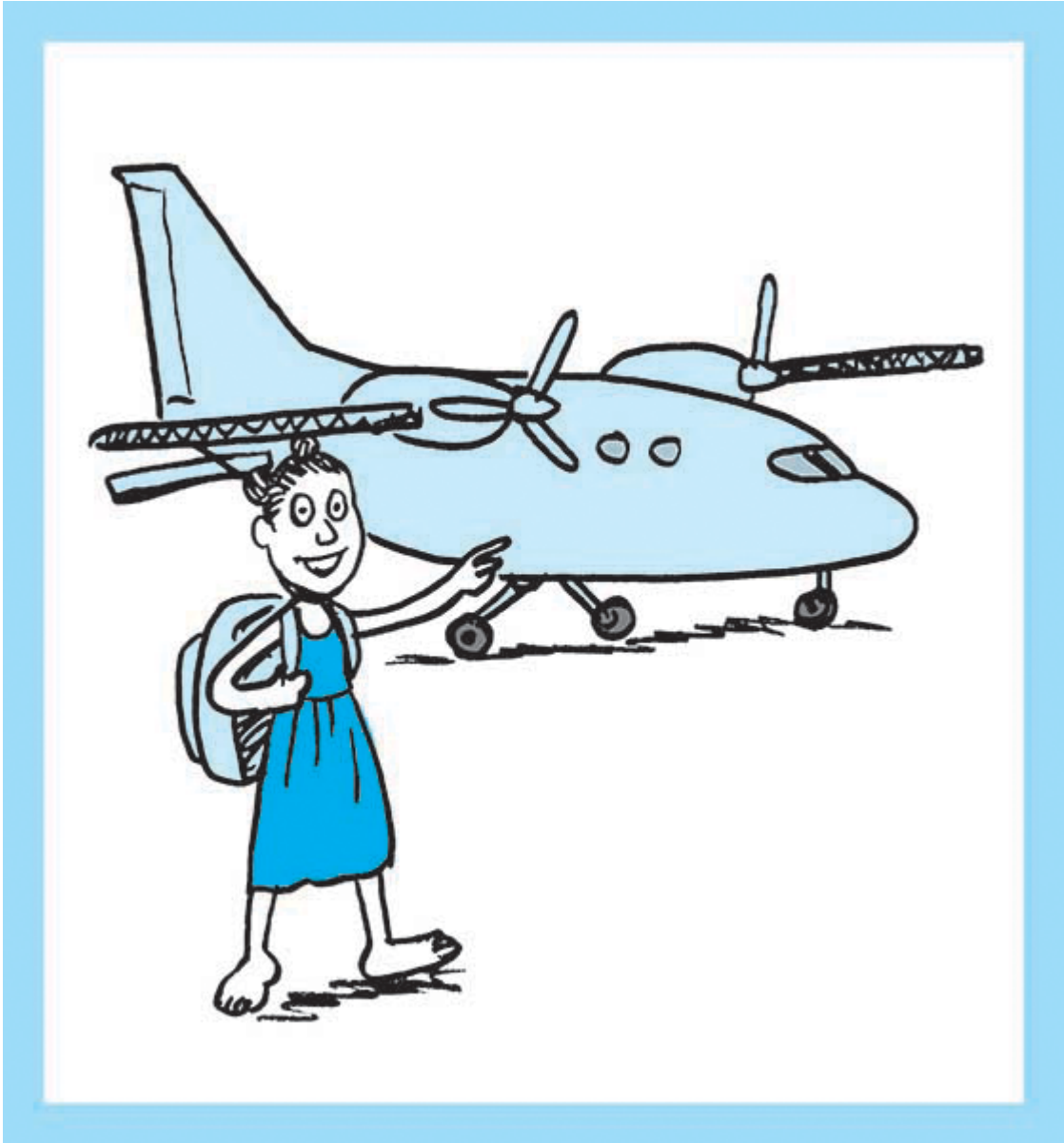
This is a car.

I fly in a plane.



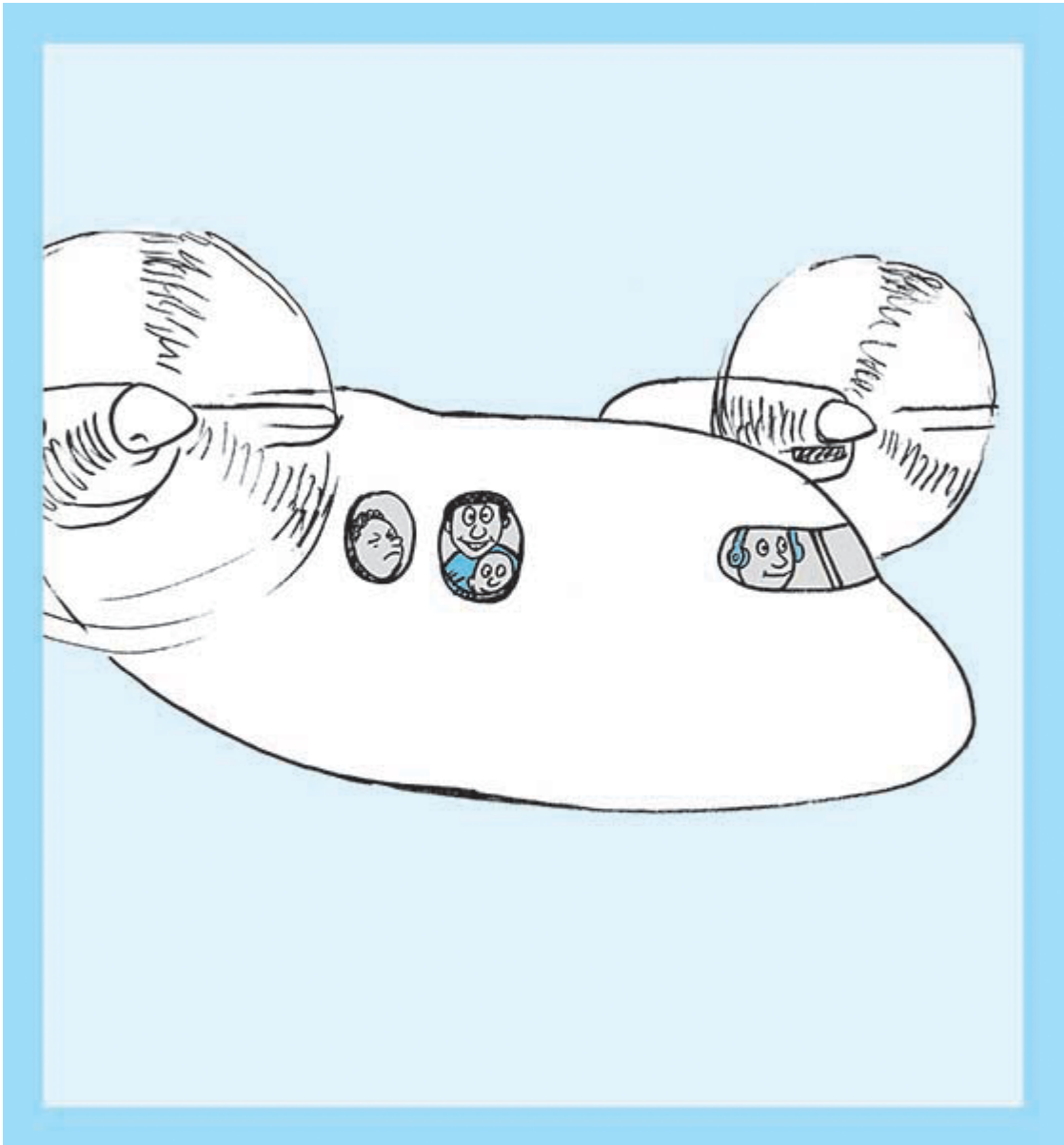
I fish in a boat.
