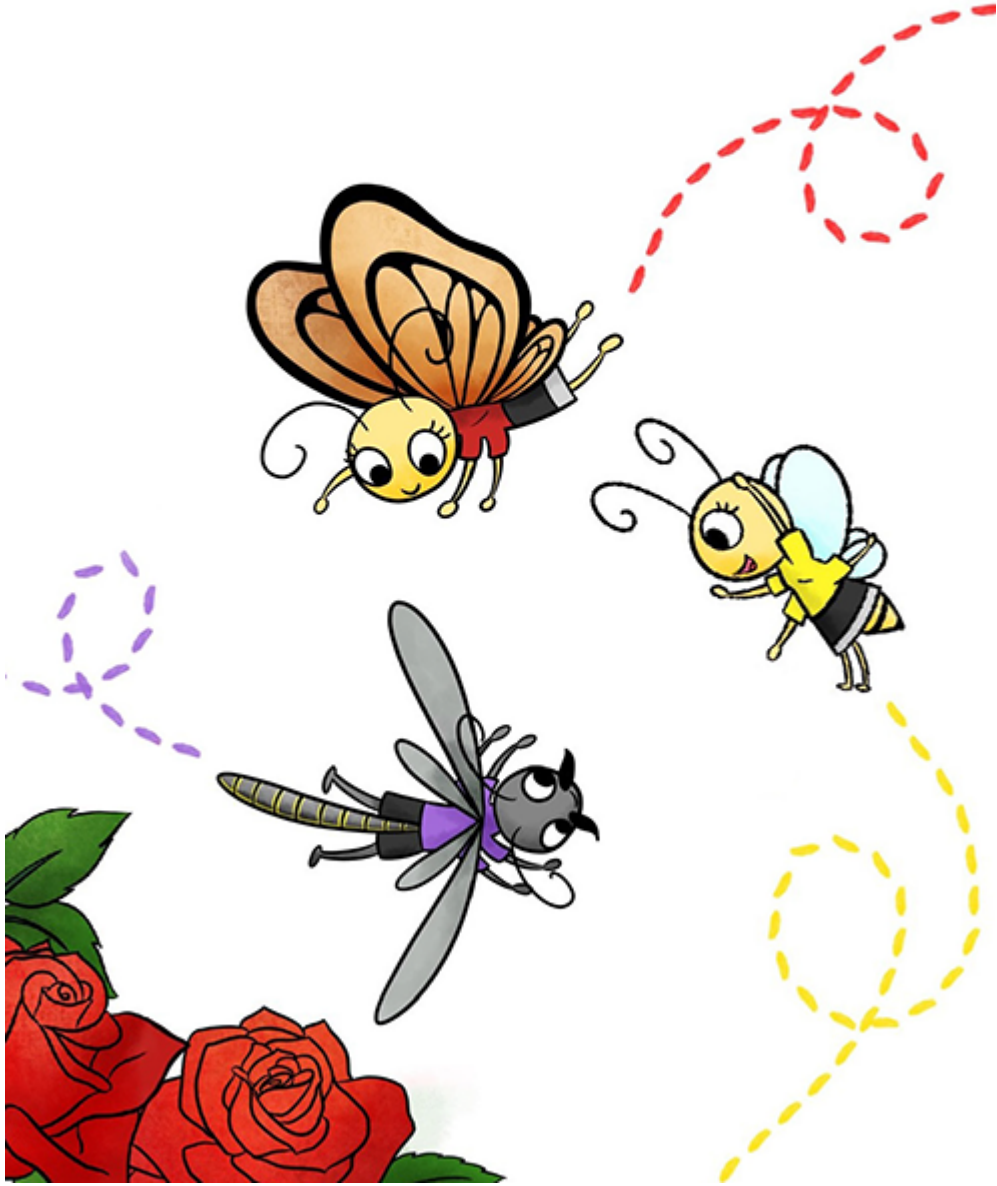
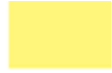


Flower Garden

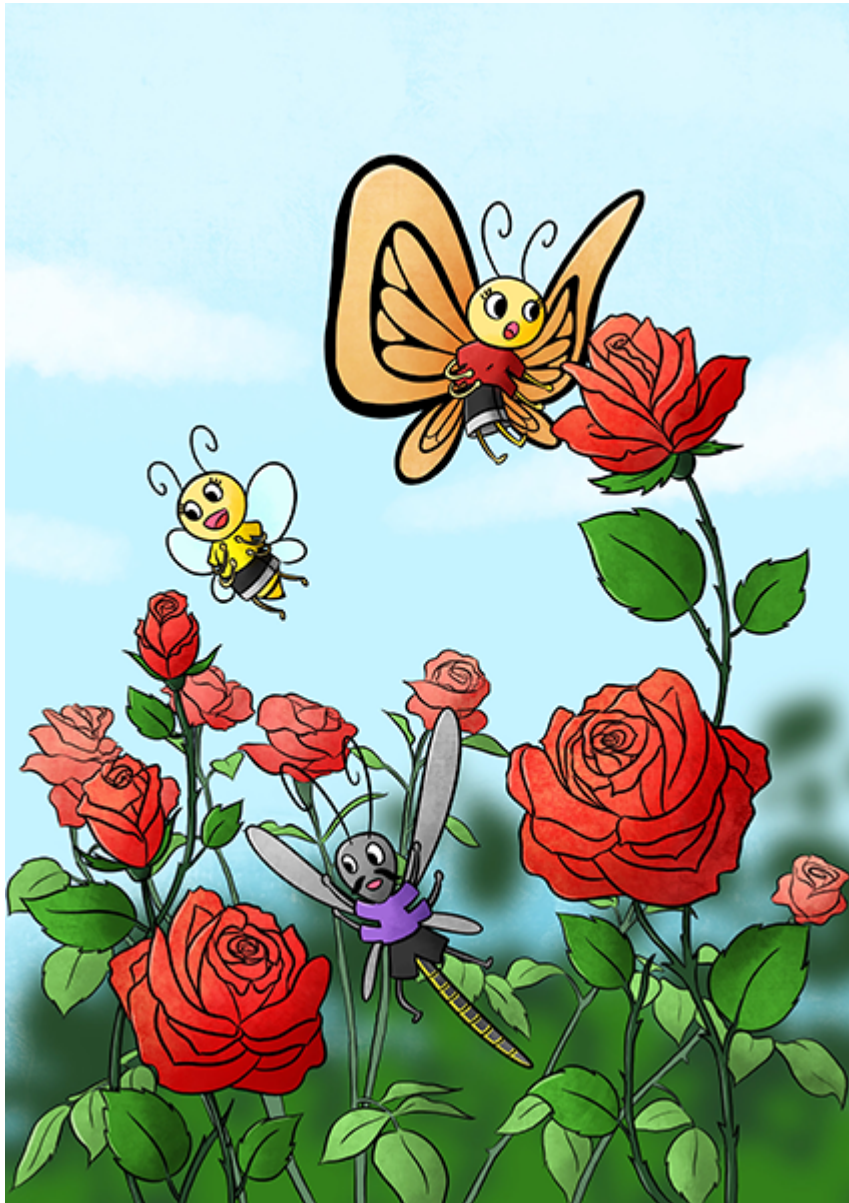


One morning, a bee, butterfly and dragonfly were flying around the flower garden.
