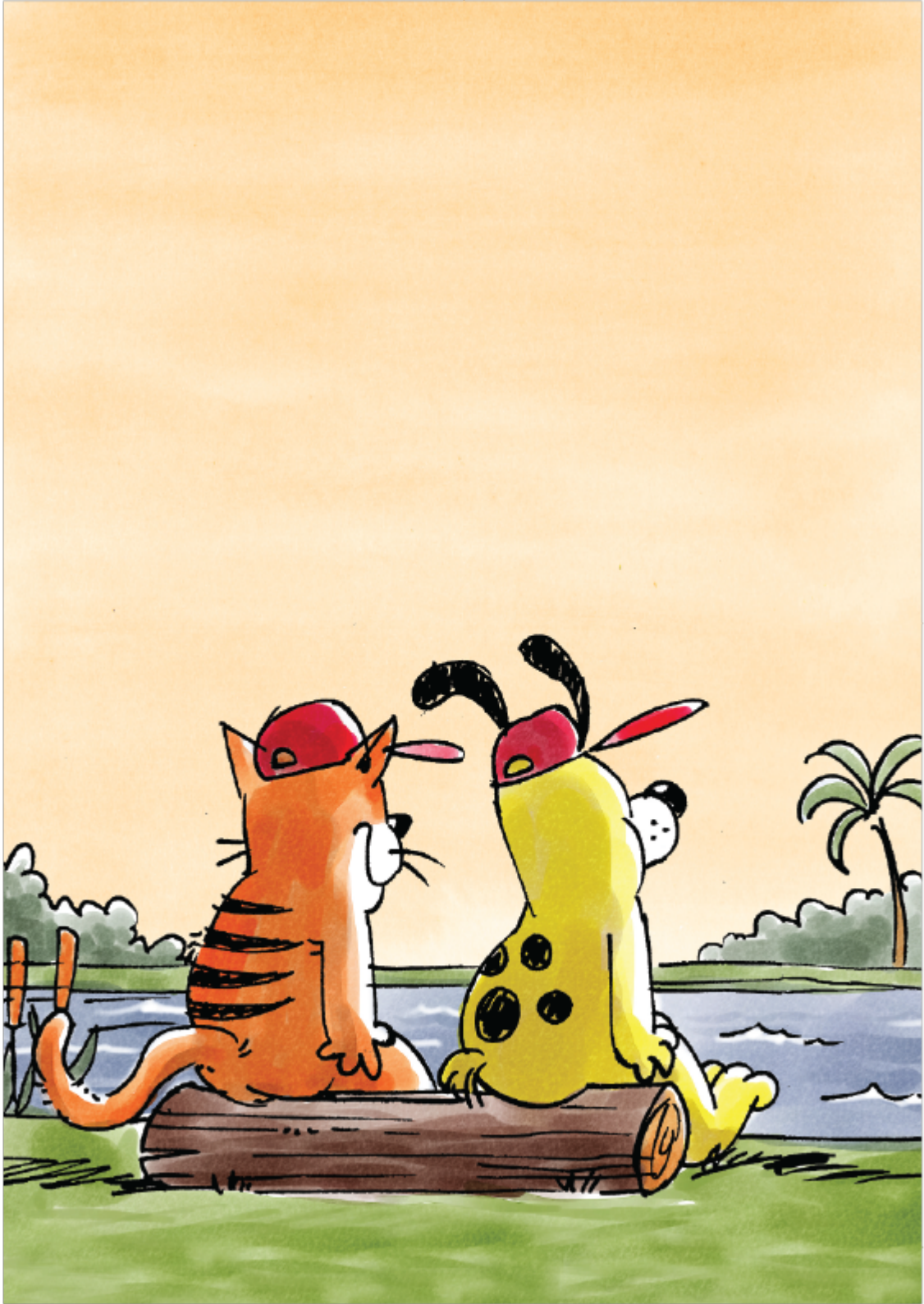
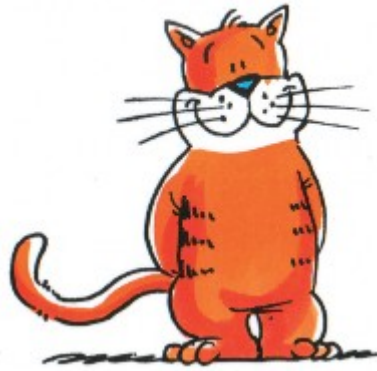


Cat & Dog and the Hat

This is Dog.



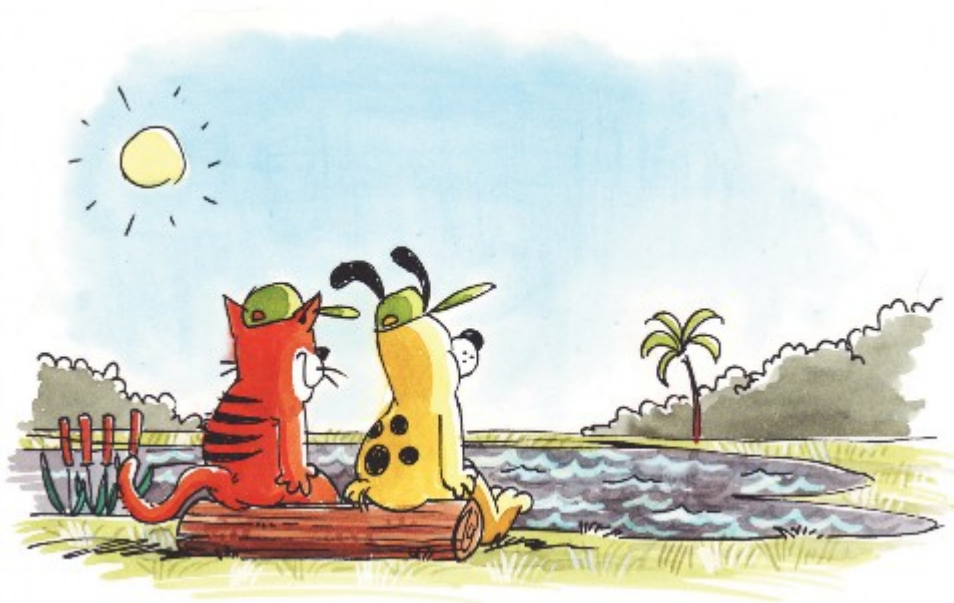
Cat and Dog have a hat. It is a new hat. It is a green hat.
