


The Bottle Boat

Kongkea is ten years old. She lives with her father, Sok, and mother, Som. They sell groceries from their home.




Every evening, Kongkea swims with her father in a pond near their home.

Kongkea searched for ideas in books at home and in her school library.




Kongkea and her mom searched the internet together. "Aha!" Kongkea said happily. "I know what I'll make!"




She began collecting materials for her project.
